

Use of cookies on the website attelsr.lv

Cookies Policy

Cookies shall be used for improvement of the quality of the content, more convenient use and adjustment to the needs of users of the website attelsr.lv. When using this site, you agree with the use of cookies.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that the browser (such as Internet Explorer, Microsoft Edge, Mozilla Firefox, Safari etc.) stores on your device (computer, mobile phone, tablet PC) at the moment, when us visit the website, in order to identify the browser or save information or settings in the browser.

Cookies operate like a memory of the particular webpage (website), enabling the webpage to remember your device during the time of next visit. Cookies also help the site to remember your login and settings (for example, language, font size and other displaying settings), with which you have chosen to view the site in order they should not be specified again each time.

How do we use cookies?

The internet environment analysis tool Google Analytics, offered by Google, Inc (hereinafter - Google) is being used on the website attelsr.lv.

Google Analytics uses cookies - text files sent to your computer, through which it is possible to analyse the behaviour model of users: pages viewed, geographical places of location of users, time of stay on the site, device etc. Google will receive for use the information that the cookie is creating about your habits, which will be stored on servers in the USA. Google will use it in order to analyse your behaviours as a user on this website, develop notices to website operators regarding visitation of the website and provide other services in relation to activities on the website and use of internet.

If you prefer that the company Attēls R does not obtain information about your activities on the website attelsr.lv, you shall activate the additional tool Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on (<https://support.google.com/analytics/answer/181881>). This additional tool communicates with Google Analytics JavaScript, in order to specify that data on the relevant visit of the online site should not be sent to Google Analytics.

Controlling and deletion of cookies

We cannot delete our cookies ourselves as long as they are placed on your browser.

However, the majority of browsers can be set in a way to block placement of cookies on the computer. These settings mostly are available in sections Help, Tools or Editing.

You may disable or limit the use of cookies, but without cookies it will not be possible to use all functions of sites valuably. If you will delete or block cookies, you will have to manually adjust the settings each time, when you will visit the site, and there is a possibility that some of the functions offered by the website and some of the services will not work.

When visiting our website with an enabled plug-in, your internet browser will establish a link with Facebook and Twitter servers, and the fact that you have visited our website will be further delivered to Facebook and Twitter even if you have not logged in to your Facebook or Twitter account or activated the plug-in, namely clicked on that.

Necessary (mandatory) cookies

These cookies are required in order you could freely visit and browse the website and use the opportunities provided therein, including to acquire information on products and services and acquire them. These cookies identify your device, but do not disclose your identity, as well as they do not gather and collect information. Without these cookies the website will not be able to valuably operate, for example, provide the information necessary for you, to provide the requested services on the portal, connection to the profile, application for a product or service.

These cookies are stored on your device until the moment, when the web browser is closed.

Such cookies are used on the basis of the legitimate interest of the company Attēls R to ensure operation of the website and to provide services to the user.

Functional cookies

By functional cookies the site remembers settings chosen by you and performed selections, in order the use of the site would be more convenient for you.

These cookies are regularly stored on the device of the user.

Such cookies are used on the basis of the legitimate interest of the company Attēls R to ensure and improve the operation of the website and to provide services to the user.

Analytical (performance) cookies

Analytical cookies collect information about how you use the website, detects the most frequently visited sections, including content that you select, when browsing the site. Information is used for the purpose of analysis, in order to establish that the users of the site are interested in, and to be able to improve the functionality of the site, making it more convenient to use. Analytical cookies only identify your device, but do not disclose your identity.

In certain cases few of the analytical cookies, instead of the owner of the site, in accordance with instructions thereof and only in accordance with the specified purposes, are managed by third persons - data processors (operators), such as Google Inc.

The legal ground for use of such cookies is the legitimate interest of the company Attēls R to improve the operation of the website, for example to provide the search function.

For how long cookies are stored

Unless it is determined otherwise, cookies are stored as long as the operation, for the purpose of which they were collected, is performed and afterwards they are deleted.
